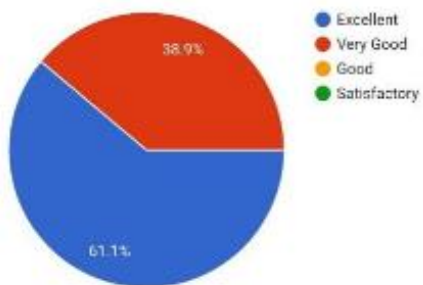

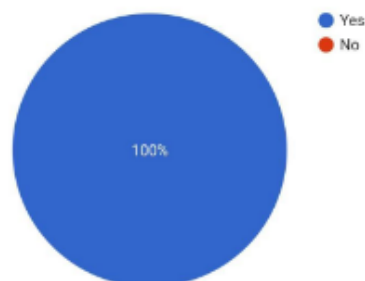


Graphical representation of feed-back:
