Imparting values through parenting styles

- 1. Authoritarian.
- 2. Authoritative.
- 3. Permissive.

1.<u>Authoritarian</u>.

*Parents value control & unquestioning obedience.

*Constantly imposing discipline.

*Children cannot make independent choices because their parents strictly control them

2.Authoritative.

- Parents are rational & democratic they stress on social values and respect individual identity.
 - * Children are encouraged to be independent.
 - * Children are secure, self controlled, reliant and assertive.

3.<u>Permissive</u>.

* Parents give unlimited freedom to their children.

* Parents are non-controlling and relatively warm.

* Children receive very little guidance from their parents and this makes them uncertain and anxious about their activities.

*Information about age appropriate behavior blend

*With intuition leads to effective parenting

a. Timingb. Appropriate explanationc. Consistencyd. The person who punishes

EFFECTIVE WAYS OF PUNISHMENT

1.Power Assertion-withdrawal of privileges physical forms of punishment (only in an emergency).

2. Induction- setting limits showing logical cause and effect, explaining & reasoning.

3. Withdrawal of love- ignoring, isolating or showing dislike for the child.


