The seminar was hosted by Miss Satyabhama Yadav of DLLE Department . The program began by welcoming all the dignitaries, staff and students and giving the necessary instructions to be followed. The program started by "Deep prajvalan" i.e. lighting of the lamp by the chief guest and speaker "Captain Dr. Rohini Sivabalan" along with Saraswati Vandana to garland the blessings of Goddess Saraswati. This was followed up with the felicitation of the guests by Principal Dr. Moses kolet. Then, captain Dr. Rohini Sivabalan began with the topic of the program.

She explained the True meaning of empowering women. Women empowerment means giving equal right to women. She highlighted the status of women in the past and compared it with the present. Though there is a significant change but that is not enough. Women still lacks primary rights at some places. There are misconceptions about women empowerment. Empowering women doesn't mean deeming the men down. Women must not misuse her rights. It is all matter of equality. She enlisted that girl education should be given importance, female infanticide should be stopped. After all if there is no woman then who will give birth to new generation? She also shared her own stories and experiences. She says that if we don't take significant steps , we will have to keep on conducting sessions on women Empowerment and still lave a very little change. " Thoughts must change as per the changing generations". In this way she concluded the topic. The program was broadcast Instagram live for offline attendees

The entire session was very informative and many participants doubts were cleared by question and answer session. The session came to an end with some encouraging words from Dr. Vinda Manjramkar ,Principal Dr. Moses Kolet sir, followed by the Vote of thanks.

Registration for the seminar was free. The session was attended by 72 participants and it was held in the Patanjali sabhagruh in offline mode following all covid-19 norms. 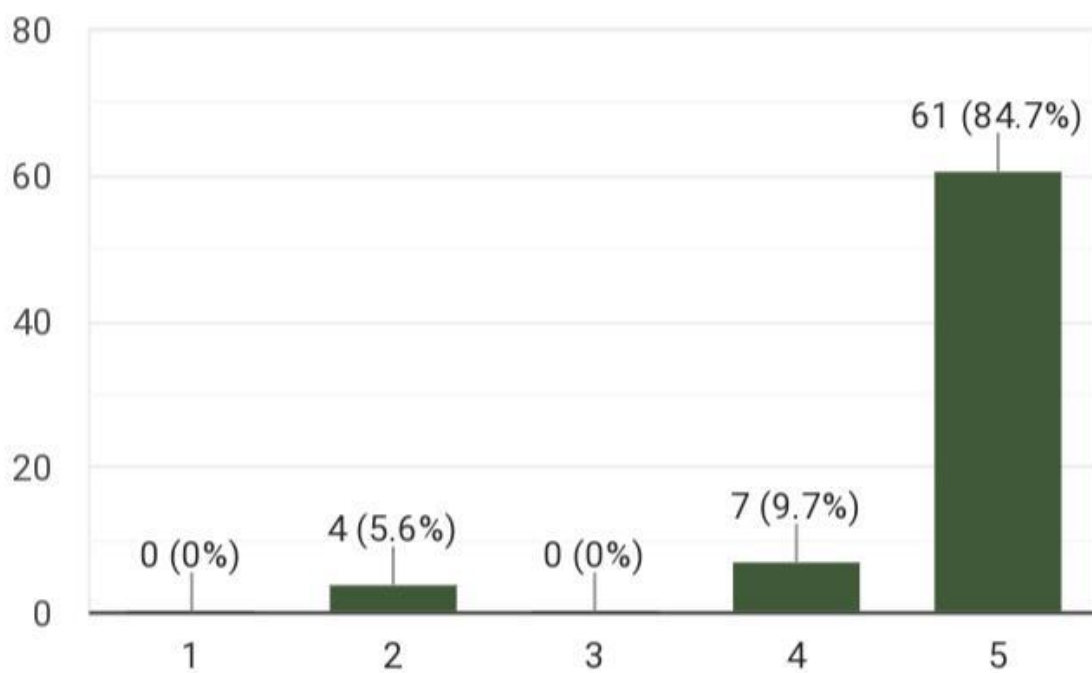
