As many as 3 to 8 counseling sessions were conducted with clients, as per the requirement. In Personal Counseling Sessions various issues like, Emotional Management, Behavioral Alterations, Anger Management, Stress Management, Disorder Management, Career Guidance, Acquisition of Study Skills, Rehabilitation etc. were addressed.

• Group Counseling:

The various Group Counseling Sessions conducted during this academic year are as follows:

- a) Stress Management Workshop was held for T.Y.B.A. Geography class on 2nd April 2010.
- b) On 6th July 2010, Stress Management Workshop was held at the *Kutir* on College campus for Stress Management students.
- c) On 12th July 2010, Relaxation Sessions were held in Vivekananda Kendra for SYBA Psychology students.
- d) On 6th August 2010, a Workshop was organized on the theme of 'Voice Culture'.
