**FAQ's about admission to 3 years Degree in Law**

Q.1. Who are eligible for admission into Law program?

Ans. Candidate securing at least 45% at graduation level in open category and atleast 40% in case of SC and ST candidates and or 45% at PG Level in one sitting only.

Q.1A. Can LL.B. be pursued along with any other course?

No. Candidate can not pursue two courses simultaneously.

Q.2.What is the duration of the course?

Ans. 3 years.

Q.2A. What degree is conferred on completion?

After successful completion of 2 years under the law course B.G.L. will be conferred and after completing 3 years candidate will be awarded LL.B degree.

Q. 3. What is the fee?

Ans. Current fees (there may be a hike)

Q.5. When will admission start?

Ans. Admission to First year LL.B Course will start only after the declaration of BA/B.Com./BSC result of Mumbai university. Detailed admission notification will be uploaded on the website of the Institute ([www.vpmthane.org](http://www.vpmthane.org))

Q.6. What is the procedure for admission?

Ans. After the declaration of Mumbai university results of BA., B.Com. & B.Sc., admission form will be uploaded on institutes' website.

Candidates will fill up online applications. After submitting the duly filled in form, candidate will take a print out of the submitted form, print out will accompany the following documents.

1. Date of Birth certificate.
2. Caste certificate if applicable.
3. 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> Mark sheet.
4. Mark lists of 3 years (First, Second & Third year) integrated Degree Course on the basis of which candidate seeks admission.
5. Post graduation mark list if admission is sought on that basis.

Q.7. Is there reservation for different communities?

Reservation as prescribed by Govt. of Maharashtra

1. SC - 13%
2. ST – 07%
3. DT/NT/VNJT – 11%

4. OBC – 19%
5. SBC – 2%
6. Handicapped, ward of the defense personnel in service/ex-serviceman studies high excellay. Performance at state/National level in sports and or cultural event. And ward of the freedom fighter – 3 %

Q.8. Is there management quota?

Ans. Yes, 15% of total seats – 320 (48 seats) (Arts – 91, Comm. – 91, Science – 90)

Q.9. Is attendance compulsory?

Ans. Yes. Under ordinance 119 of Mumbai University, 75% attendance is compulsory of the total lectures delivered.

Q.10. Is the college recognized?

Ans. Yes, college is recognized by Bar Council of India and affiliated to University of Mumbai having been accredited by NAAC and & 'Aided' by Government of Maharashtra.
